Training Scholarships are subject to the following:

- Applications are received 1-calendar month before the training activity.
- Training scholarships will be provided for researchers, staff & students that targets the Wesfarmers
  Centre of Infectious Diseases' (WCVID) aim of reducing the burden of important childhood infectious
  diseases. WCVID's training scholarships can be used for, but not limited to:
  - Advanced courses (e.g. the Advanced Course of Vaccinology, Advanced Course on Diagnostics organised by Fondation Mérieux, etc.)
  - Technical courses and training (i.e. on bio-informatics; 'omics' platforms)
  - o On-the-job training at other research organisations

application, and a flyer and/or web link detailing the training opportunity.

- Invitation to give a lecture or oral presentation at a conference (poster presentations are not usually supported)
- Support for WCVID supported staff and researchers based in regional Western Australian to attend the WCVID Retreat
- Funds cannot be used for conference attendance.
- Higher degree research (HDR) students receiving a WCVID top-up scholarship awarded after 2017 are eligible to apply for funds to attend conferences for the duration of their scholarship.
- The maximum funding that an individual can receive for training purposes is \$10,000 over any 3-year period. This will usually be as smaller amounts granted at different times, adding up to the maximum limit.
